Terms and Conditions

1. Booking & Payment – Individual Bookings (if applicable)

If you wish to confirm a course at Scarborough International School of English, please complete and return your application form along with the registration fee of £50 and a deposit of £100. The registration fee and deposit are per person per course. The registration fee is non-refundable and non-transferable. All remaining fees plus bank charges must be cleared in the school's account before your arrival in the UK, and Scarborough International School of English is under no obligation to provide a course or accommodation if this requirement is not met.

2. Booking & Payment – Group Bookings (if applicable)

If you wish to book one of our Special Group Package courses, please send a group booking form with the registration fee of £50 per student and a deposit of £100 per student. All remaining fees plus bank charges must be cleared in the school's account 4 weeks before your arrival in the UK. We are under no obligation to provide a course or accommodation if this requirement is not met.

3. Visas (non EU/EEA nationals)

If you require a visa to study in the UK, please contact the nearest British Embassy or Consulate to enquire about and arrange a visa for entry into the United Kingdom. For more information regarding visas please visit www.ukvisas.gov.uk. A deposit of £200 plus a £50 registration fee are required for students wishing to obtain the confirmation documents required for visa applications. If you cancel your course before arrival due to visa refusal, we shall refund your tuition fees in full minus the £200 deposit and the £50 registration fee. A refund will only be issued on receipt of the visa refusal letter. SIS will notify UKVI if a student fails to arrive at the school after being issued with an acceptance letter.

4. General

Scarborough International School of English reserves the right to change starting dates, course programmes and locations without prior notice in the event of circumstances beyond its control or in the best interests of the school. Scarborough International School of English accepts beginners by prior arrangement. Contact info@english-language.uk.com.

5. Photographs

Occasionally photographs or videos may be taken during your stay. If you do not wish photographs or videos of you or your students to be used for marketing purposes, please advise us in writing at the time of booking.

6. Insurance

Scarborough International School of English does not accept liability in case of illness, accident, loss or damage to personal effects or property. Damage to school or homestay property must be paid for in full. You are strongly advised to take out insurance before travel that will cover medical problems, accidental loss, damage to property or course cancellation. Scarborough International School can recommend an insurance provider if required.

7. Bank & Public Holidays

The school is closed on English public holidays. There is no reduction in fees when there is a public holiday.

8. Juniors (7-12yrs)

Parents/guardians accompanying juniors are responsible for the children in their care when they are not in class or participating in supervised afternoon activities with the school. Homestay Provider/s take this responsibility for those juniors who are not accompanied by parents/guardians.

9. Behaviour

Any student who causes severe disciplinary problems during the course, exhibits disruptive behaviour or has a poor attendance record may be excluded from the school and asked to return home immediately at their own/parents'/guardians' expense; no refund will be given. If a student's attendance drops below 80%, he/she will not be eligible for a certificate at the end of the course.

10. Force Majeure

Scarborough International School of English is not liable in the event of the school being unable to supply services to which it is contractually bound resulting from causes outside the school's control, such as but not limited to, natural disasters, adverse weather conditions, closure or congestion of airports, strikes, civil disturbance, pandemic and the like. No refund will be made in such circumstances.

11. Accommodation

Arrival and departure Information: the school's accommodation week is Sunday arrival before course start date and Saturday departure following course finish date; extra nights are available on request at an additional charge (subject to availability).
We do not place students in a homestay with another student who speaks the same first language, unless requested.

12. Student Holidays

Students may take a holiday of 1 week every 12 weeks provided one week's notice is given to the school. Students on a course of 12 weeks or longer on a visa should take any holidays into consideration when applying for that visa. Normal accommodation fees must be paid.

13. Cancellation Policy

All cancellations should be applied for in writing. The course deposit and registration fee will not be refunded at any time. All remaining course and accommodation fees are refundable if a booking is cancelled more than 14 days prior to the arrival date. If a booking is cancelled within 7 days of the arrival date 1 week's tuition and 1 week's accommodation (if relevant) are payable. If you leave the course after arrival, early or miss any lessons, no refund or credit will be given, including in case of illness.
